NOTICE OF RACE

Permission Number of the Austrian Sailing Federation 7410

1 Rules

- 1.1 The Seascape 18 Central European Cup 2017 is subject to the Racing Rules of Sailing published by World Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In addition, the Race Regulation of the Austrian Sailing Federation OeSV 2017 applies; further the standard Sailing Instructions of the OeSV 2017, the Sailing Instructions of the AGS, the Class Rules of the Seascape 18 Class and this Notice of Race.
- 1.3 The addition [DP] in a rule of the Notice of Race or in the Sailing Instructions means, that the penalty for a breach of rule is at the discretion of the protest committee and may be less than a disqualification.
- 1.4 If the Class Rules do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for life jackets.
- 1.5 The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the anti-doping rules of the Austrian Bundessportorganisation shall apply. For doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate at the regatta.

2 Publicity

The ISAF Advertising Code will apply. Organizing authorities may ask competitors to display a sponsor flag and/or advertising stickers of the event sponsor on both side of the bow for the duration of the event. [DP]



3 Eligibility and notification

3.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the **Seascape 18** Class, registered in a club recognized to the ISAF and the Seascape 18 Class. The Boats must be conformed the class rules and insured against liability damage (minimum cover EUR 1.500.000).

The Seascape 18 can be sailed with two or three crew.

Against the class rules anchors are not permitted.

3.2 Helmsmen have to be members of a club recognized to their national authority or have to be individual members of their national authority.

3.3 Helmsmen are required to possess a sailing license from their national authority.

3.4 Participants who are entitled to participate will register online by Wednesday, May 10th, 2017, at www.ag-segeln.at, with simultaneous transfer of the entree fee to the **AGS**.

3.5 There is a minimum of **10** entries at entry closing date May 10, 2017. In case there are less than 10 boats the regatta will be started with the Yardstick race together which occur to the same time (separate scoring).

4 Entry Fee

Early Entry Fee until 10th May 2017 is €120,- (doublehanded) or €180,- (three member crew).

Late Entry Fee until 26th May 2017 is €140,- (doublehanded) or €200,- (three member crew)

Children up to the age of 17 are free of entry.

5 Registration

Registration time is:

Thursday 25th May 2017, 6 pm – 8 pm and

Friday 26th May 2017, 9 am – 12 am in the office of the **AGS**.

Proof of insurance, membership cards and sailing license shall be provided upon registration.

A valid measurement form shall be available in case of measurement checks.

6 First start

Friday 26th May 2017 at 2 pm

7 Last possible start

Sunday 28th May 2017 at 3 pm

8 Sailing instruction

The sailing instructions are distributed during registration.



9 Race Courses

There will be standard courses with a target time of 40 minutes.

10 Scoring

8 races with 1 discards are scheduled. If less than 4 races are completed there will be no discards scheduled.

3 completed races are required to constitute the Central European Cup.

No more than 4 races will be sailed per day.

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

11 Berthing

A slipway is provided next to the sailing club.

12 Mooring area

The regatta participants are assigned berths. Depending on the number of participants, berths can also be allocated to club buoys or nearby clubs. In these cases a permanent inflatable transfer is organized. [DP]

13 Radio communication

Excluded in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. [DP]

14 Awards

14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats.

14.2 Give-away for all participants.

15 Disclaimer, Pictures, Data

Racing competitors agree to be bound by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Racing competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the nautical qualities of their boat, the rigging, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the Seascope 18 Central European Cup, relieving of any responsibility the Organizing Authority, the Jury, the International Seascope 18 Association and all National Seascope 18 Associations and all persons involved in their organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

In any case, competitors agree that the Organizing Authority, AGS, the International Seascope 18 Association and all National Seascope 18 Associations, the sponsors of the Traunseewoche and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members, competitors or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Seascope 18 Central European Cup.

The Organizing Authority reminds the participants that there is commercial shipping traffic in the vicinity of the race area and the participants are expected to observe the IRPCAS in relation to all such vessels.



15.1 Recording in picture and sound

All participating persons agree with the announcement or participation that they and their boats take records in picture and sound and that these will be published indefinitely for reporting on the event and for their application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs allowed.

15.2 Minor

In the case of minors, their declarations of intent are to be issued by their legal representative or by a person authorized by the legal representative in writing.

15.3 Others

The organization of the event starts well in advance. Reimbursement of the registration fee or travel expenses is not provided. In exceptional cases and only to the extent that the organizer has spared something, the registration fee will be replaced; But not in cases of force majeure.

Any changes to the Notice of Race and other rules (such as sailing instructions) are reserved, but they are announced in a timely manner.

All prizes, in particular material and reminder prizes will be forfeited if these are not collected personally at the prize giving.

The law of the Republic of Austria shall apply to questions which are not subject to the sports federation's autonomy. Court of Jurisdiction is the local and factually competent court for Gmunden.

16 Insurance

All participating boat must have a valid liability insurance with a minimum sum of € 1,500,000 per casualty or the equivalent case of damage.

17 Anticipatory Framework Program

Thursday 25th May 2017, 7 pm, invitation to dinner with live band.

Friday 26th May 2017, 8 pm, invitation to the Sailors party.

Saturday 27th May 2017 Prize giving ceremony at the clubhouse about 1.5 hours after the end of the last race.
