2. RULES
 - 2.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 2.2. No national authority prescriptions will apply.

 - 2.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
3. ADVERTISING
 - 3.1. The World Sailing Advertising Code will apply.
 - 3.2. Organizing authorities may ask competitors to display a sponsor flag and/or advertising stickers of the event sponsor on both side of the bow for the duration of the event.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Regatta is open to all boats of Seascope 18 Class and Seascope 24 class.
- 4.2. Pre-registration shall be submitted online at www.seascopecup.com/registrations/ no later than 6th October 2017.
- 4.3. The fully completed entry form should be received by the organizer no later than Friday 13th October 2017 until 10:00.

5. ENTRY FEE

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on on-site registration in the Race office.

8. THE COURSES

The courses shall be Windward – Leeward, Triangle or Navigation. Detailed description will be in the SI.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. SPEED CHALLENGE

All competitors are competing also in a Speed challenge. Rankings will be made by analysing submitted GPX tracks that were submitted to the Sailing record website (<http://www.sailingrecord.com/>) not latest than Sunday 13:00, linked to the regatta. More details at the Race Office.

Only tracks made between Friday at 09:00 and Sunday at 12:00 are eligible for rankings.

We will rank the received tracks on fastest 500m averages achieved by the teams. You can use any other GPS tracking app or device as long as the minimum sampling rate on the GPX track is one position every 5 seconds. We recommend RaceQs mobile app (<http://raceqs.com/ru/home/sailing-app/>). Competitors must provide their own phone or other GPS tracking devices and take care of keeping them charged.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. 13 races will be sailed – 10 technical races, 2 navigational races and a Speed challenge.
- 11.2. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series for each class.
- 11.3. The Low point scoring system from Appendix A will be used.
- 11.4. When more than 3 technical races have been completed, the worst technical race score is excluded from boats series score. When 9 or more technical races have been completed, her two worst technical race scores are excluded from her total.
- 11.5. Navigation races and Speed challenge rankings are awarded double points.
- 11.6. When two or more double-points race are sailed, the worst double-point race score is excluded from boats series score.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in a emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restricitons also applies to mobile phones.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to:

- First three boats overall in class Seascape18.
- Winner in class Seascape18 will be declared European champion 2017.
- First boat in class Seascape24

Additional prizes will be awarded in case of sponsorship.

14. MOORINGS

Berths free of charge will be available for all boats, participants of the event, from Thursday 12th October to Sunday 15th October 2017.

15. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committe.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance of minimum coverage 1.500.000 EUR. Proof of insurance shall be provided upon registration.
